In the Panamanian language expression, the term "gnope" or "ñopa" is non-pejorative form applied to the blonde person with very white skin. It is found in disuse in the Spanish-speaking world, with the exception of Colombia and Panama. It possibly comes from a language or language of Spanish Romance origin.

The 'partyocracy' voice refers to the situation of a theoretically democratic state in which a small number of quasi-oligarchic political parties determine on the basis of their economic power the patterns of and control state management, reducing state administration to a mere execution of decisions originating within those political parties.
